“the real voyage of discovery consists not in seeking new landscapes, but in having new eyes.” (Marcel Proust)

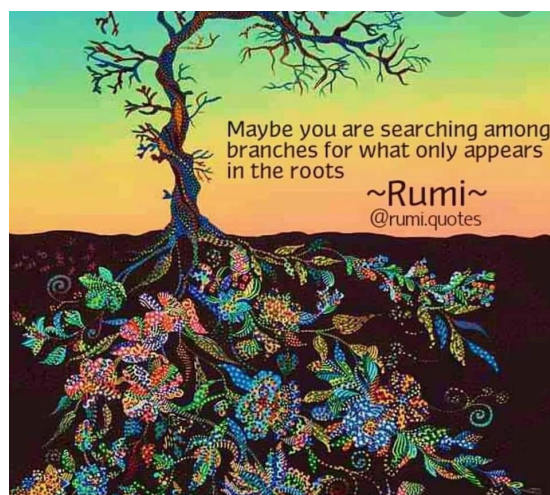
May we hear today’s message and only have eyes for Christ and Christ alone.
